Armchair	Asbestos
Bags of refuse (2 bags = 1 Item) E.g. could have 10 bags collected as one bulky request, or could have a combination (for example) of four bulky items plus two refuse sacks, or one bulky item plus 8 refuse sacks.	Aga, Rayburn or Range Cookers
Bed (A mattress and a bed base count as separate items. A large bed base that comes apart still counts as one item)	Baths
Bench (Both indoor and outdoor benches are ok)	Bathroom Suite
Bird Cage & Stand (Must be empty and clean)	Boiler
Bicycle	Builders Waste
Bookcase	Car or Motorbike parts
Cabinet	Commercial Waste
Carpet (Must be possible for it to be moved by one person. If this means that it has to be cut into pieces, then each piece will count as one item. Underlay counts as a separate item)	Concrete Posts
Chair	Doors (Internal and External)
Chest of drawers	Fence Panels
Christmas Tree (Artificial trees only, as you wouldn't take a 'real' one with you when you move)	Fire Surrounds
Compost bin (Must be empty)	Fish Tank
Computer	Fitted Kitchen
Cooker (Electric and gas both fine, but cannot collect Aga, Rayburn or Range models)	Fluid Containers (E.g. drums)
Cot	Fridges / Freezers - Commercial (Consider referring to WERM or similar organisation).
Cupboard (Not fitted kitchen units)	Garage Doors
Desk	Garden Waste
Dishwasher	Gas Bottles
Dining Chair (Up to 4 chairs count as 1 item)	Gates or fencing
Dining Table (Note: Cannot collect glass topped tables)	Greenhouses
Dressing Table (Note: Cannot collect glass topped tables)	Hazardous Waste
Electrical Item (Such as DVD/ Video player, Hi-Fi, Microwave, TV, Washing Machine, Tumble Dryer, Toaster, Vacuum Cleaner etc)	Kitchen Sink
Filing Cabinet (Must be empty and not from a business)	Kitchen Units
Fridges, Freezers and Fridge-Freezers (Domestic only) Only 2 CFC emitting items per bulky collection.	Oil Tank
Games Table (Such as mini pool table, ping-pong etc. We cannot collect full size pool/snooker tables)	Pond Liner
Garden Equipment - Lawn-Mower, Strimmer, Leafblower etc. Note: must be empty of any petrol/oil. We cannot collect ride-on lawn mowers.	Ride-on Lawn Mower (the push along type is ok)
Garden Furniture (must be possible for it to be moved by one person - each piece counts as one item)	Paint or any Liquid Materials

Gym equipment (Must be dismantled, and it must be possible for it to be moved by one person)	Piano (Check with contractor as very small ones may possibly be permitted). Electric organs or keyboards are okay.
Headboard	Radiator
Heater (Cannot collect night storage heaters as they are classed as a fixture/fitting. Any patio-heaters must have any gas bottles removed and it must be possible for the item to be moved by one person))	Rubble and Hardcore
Highchair	Sheds
Ironing Board	Trees, Shrubs or other garden waste
Keyboard / electric organ	Water Tank
Mattress (Note: we cannot collect very heavily soiled mattresses)	Window Frame
Misc. Any other sundries (as long as they are not on the 'not accepted' list) may be bagged up, and will count as 2 bags = 1 item.	Work Surface
Paddling pool (Must be deflated and empty)

Play equipment (Must be dismantled and must be possible for it to be moved by one person)

Shower Screen (Perspex only, cannot collect glass)

Sofa (Three-piece suite counts as 3 items)

Trampoline (Must be dismantled and it must be possible for it to be moved by one person)	
Trolley (E.g. a hostess trolley or shopper, but not a supermarket trolley)	
Wardrobe (Not fitted wardrobes, freestanding only)

Work Bench (The portable/mobile type only)	

Notes:

- Any other sundries (so long as they are not items on the 'not accepted' list) may be bagged up, and will count as 2 bags = 1 item.
- All items must be presented as near to the curtilage of the property as possible. We are not able to collect items from inside the home, and we will not be able to manoeuvre items past parked cars.

- A separate collection service is available for Hazardous Waste; please contact us on 0845 606 6045 for details.
- Items must be presented by 6.30 am on day of collection, or put out the night before.

Many of the above items can be taken to the Household Waste Recycling Centres free of charge (domestic waste only). Please phone 0845 606 6067 or check www.suffolkrecycling.org.uk for further details.
